September Walk



Fifteen people met at The Star & Garter Pub in Silsoe for the September walk on a slightly overcast morning, we set off into Church Road where in the front garden of one of the houses was a stone 'cage', it was built in 1795 and used as a lock up for drunks and stray animals. We then continued past the Horticultural Centre and on into the fields up a gravel track which led us past a paddock and onto a small road. Turning off the road at the wood we passed thru' a kissing gate into a field of horses and then on to the next kissing gate, from here we followed waymarkers that brought into view Pulloxhill Water Tower. We then crossed the road and went over a stile into another field, halfway along the field we turned off left thru' a kissing gate into an area for camping and caravanning. This brought us out into Pulloxhill village by The Crosskeys pub, we turned right and went up the High Street and on into Church Street, at the church of St.James we turned left at the footpath sign and went thru' the churchyard and entered the Rushymeade Meadow which gave us extensive views across towards Barton le Clay. After more kissing gates and electric fences we made our way past some stables and onto the Barton Road, we then turned left and first right thru' Hillfoot Farm and crossed two more fields before following the curved route around Upbury Moats, after this we followed a dyke until we reached a tree lined track on our left, this track took us past some cottages, then right into West End Road and back to the High Street and The Star & Garter for a well earned drink and lunch.
